

How To... Sewing Kit Pouch

Materials

10" x 13" Fabric (Outside)

10" x 13" Fabric (Inside)

Snap



Fabric Outside RIGHT Side



Fabric Outside WRONG Side

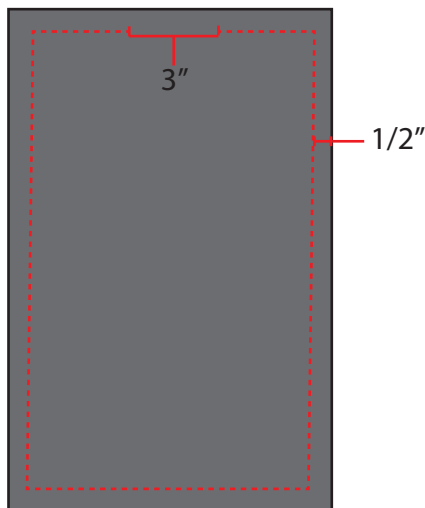


Fabric Inside RIGHT Side

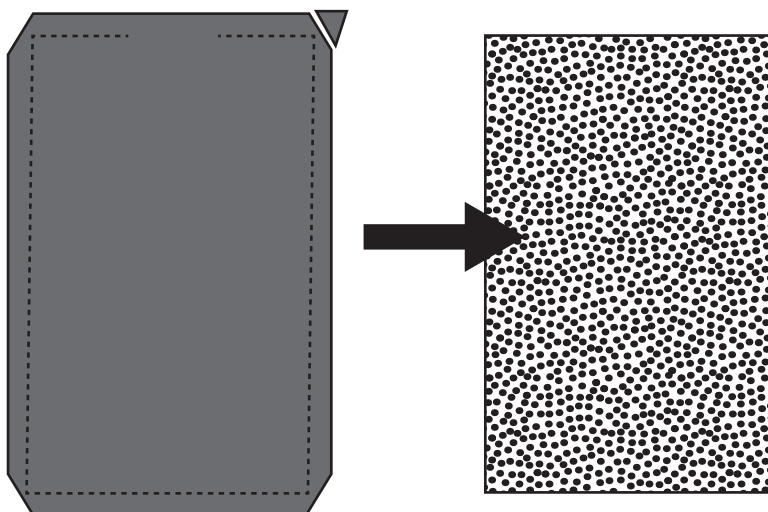


Fabric Inside WRONG Side

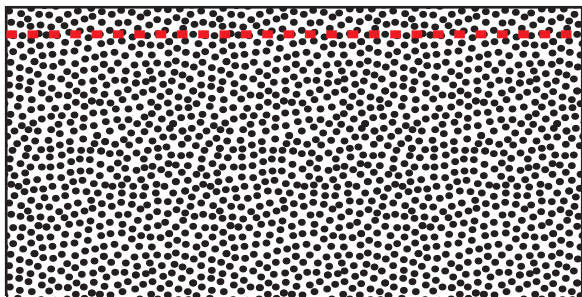
1. Sew the Outside Fabric to the Inside Fabric, right sides together, with 1/2" seam allowance. Leave a 3" opening on one shorter side.



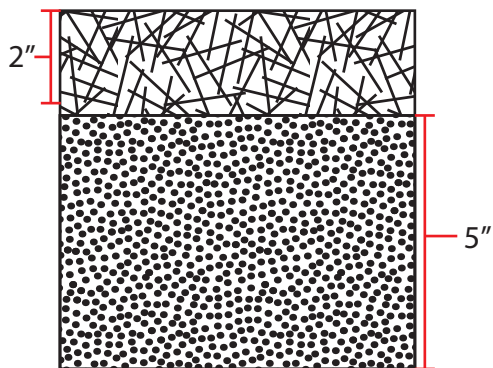
2. Clip corners and flip right side out. Poke corners square (chopsticks work great for this!), and iron.



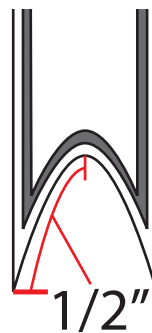
3. Sew along the short edge that has the turn opening



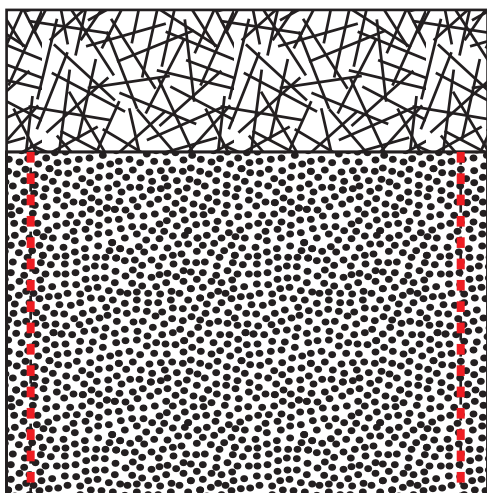
4. Fold up the lower part so that it equals 5". This is the pouch. The top portion will be the flap. Pin the bottom portion.



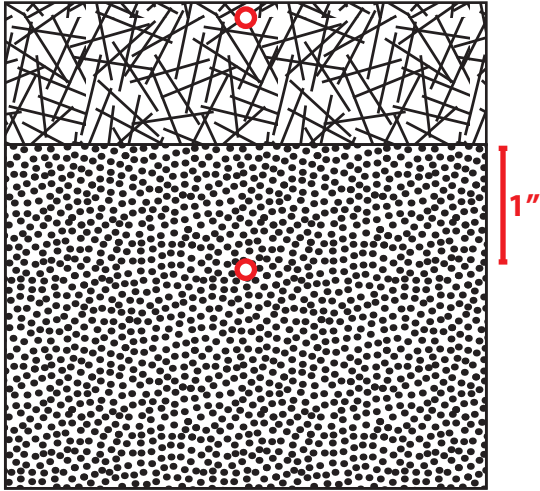
5. Optional-- Tuck in the bottom corners of the pouch. The tuck should be 1" in total length, or 1/2" on each side. Pin.



6. Stitch the outside edges of the pouch. Keep the edge lined up with right edge of pressure foot. If you are doing tucks, sew carefully over the bulky part.



7. Hand sew the snaps at the center of the flap and at the center of the pouch 1" down.



9. Fill with sewing supplies, hair accessories, stickers, pencils, charger cords, or whatever you would like!
